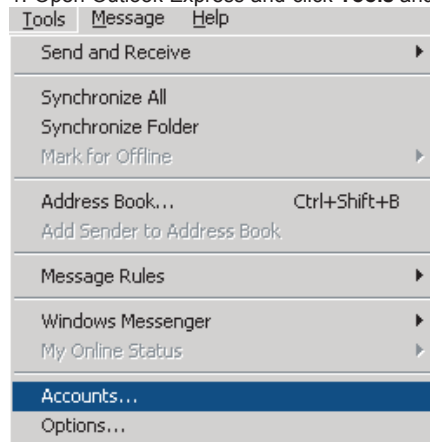
How do I setup Microsoft Outlook Express to receive e-mail using POP3 protocol?



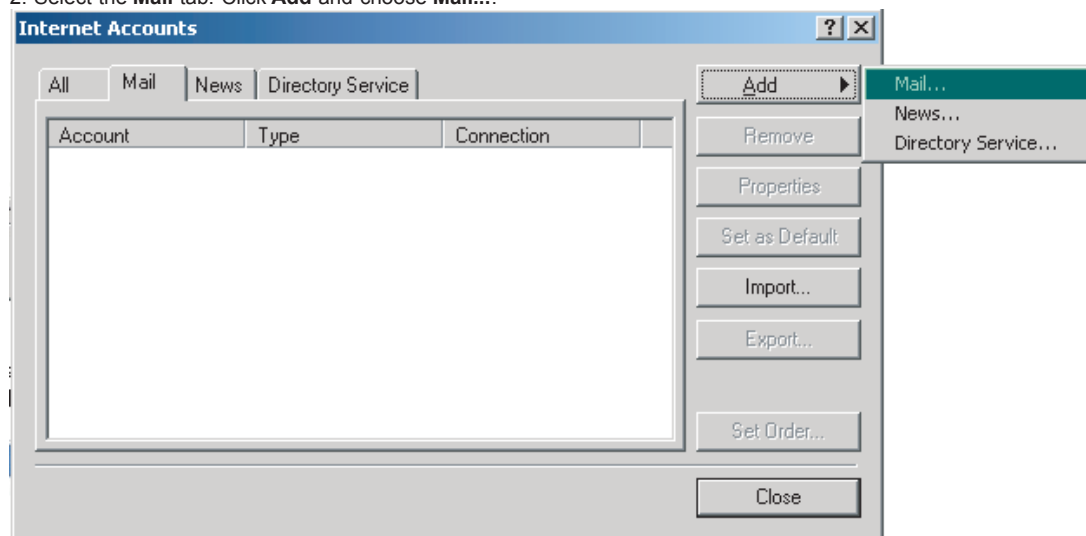
To set up Microsoft Outlook Express you will first have to acquire the necessary information by following the FAQ:

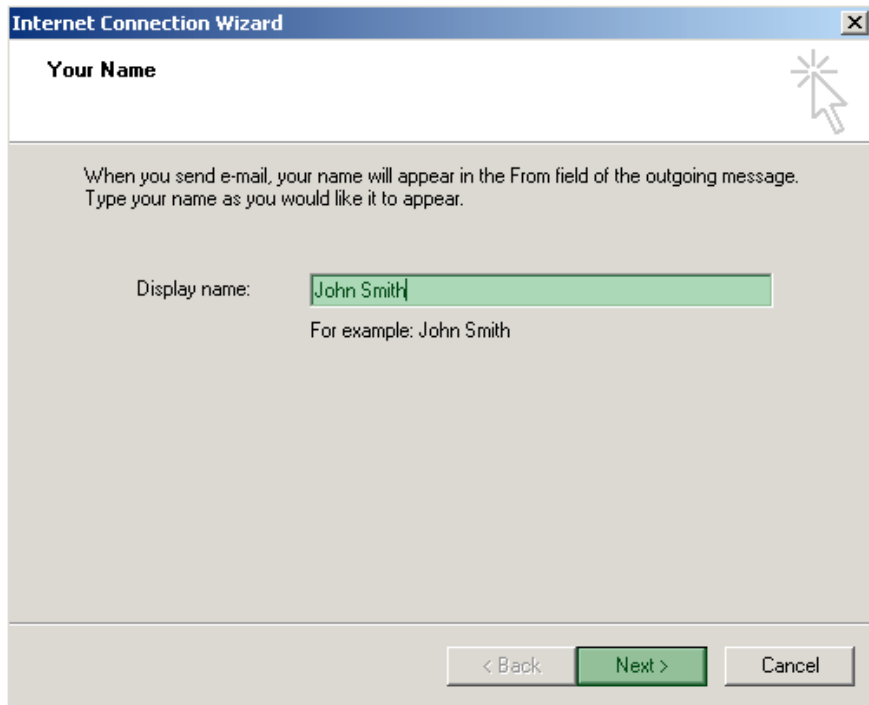
1. Open Outlook Express and click **Tools** and choose **Accounts**.



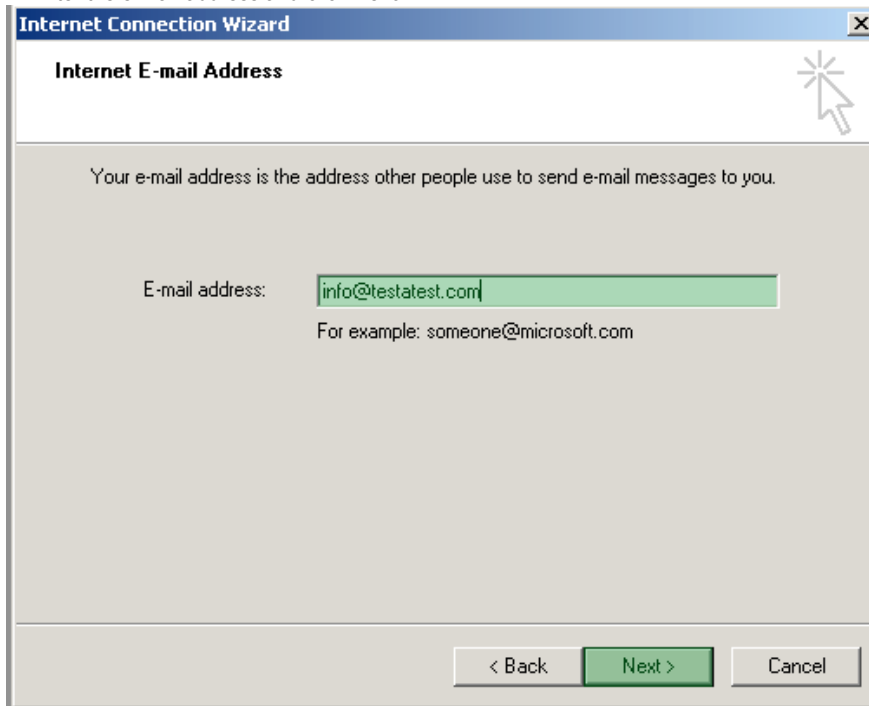
2. Select the **Mail** tab. Click **Add** and choose **Mail...**



3. Enter a Display Name and click **Next**.



4. Enter the e-mail address and click **Next**.



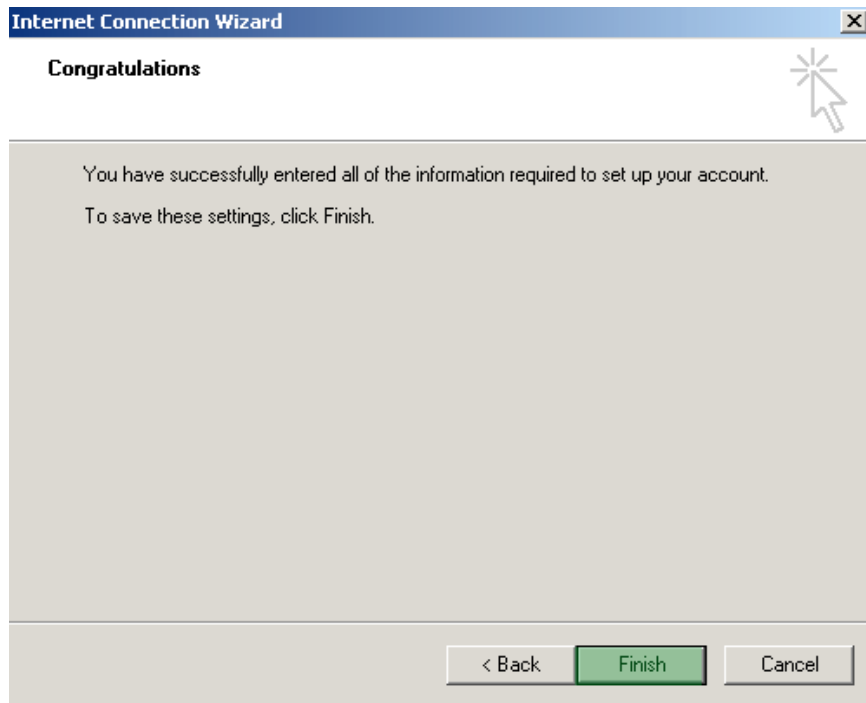
5. Choose **POP3** and enter the following:
Incoming mail: pop.1and1.com
Outgoing mail: smtp.1and1.com
and click **Next**.

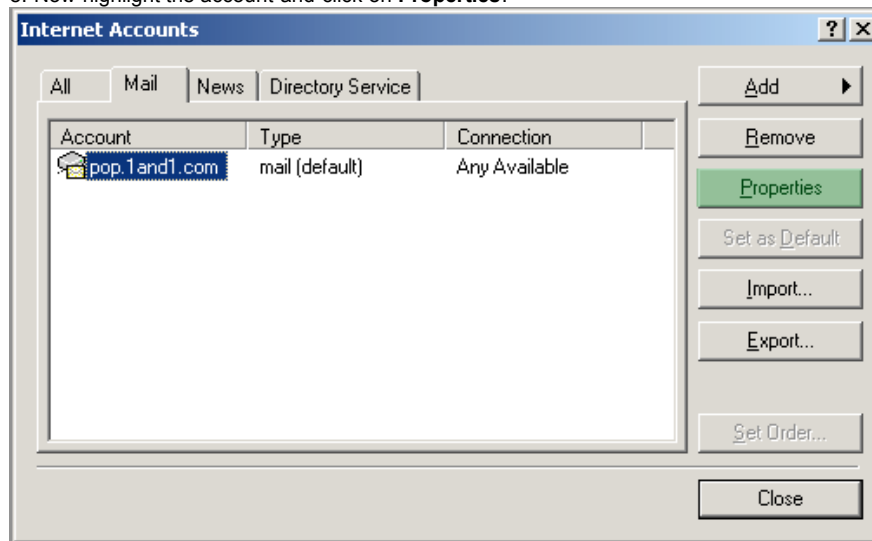
6. Enter the e-mail address. If you want the system to remember the password, check the box near **Remember Password** and enter the password. Click **Next**.

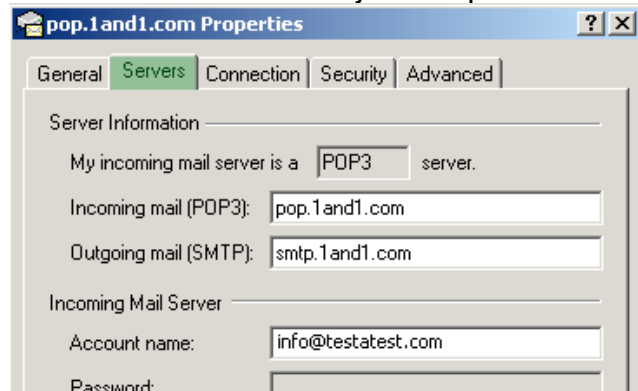
7. Click **Finish**.

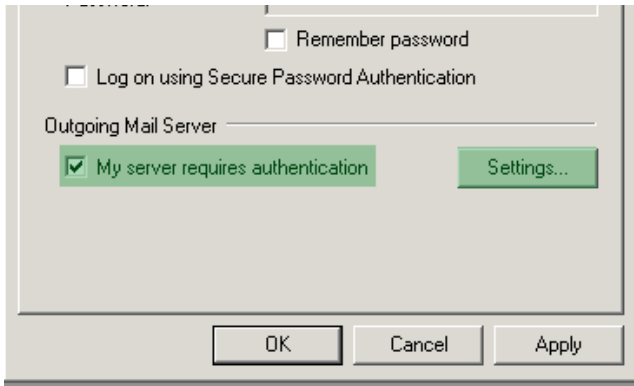


8. Now highlight the account and click on **Properties**.

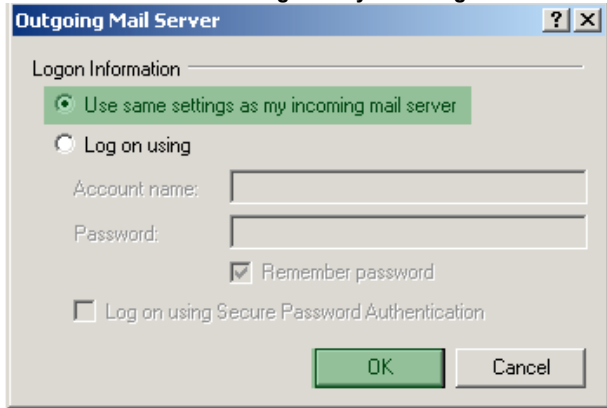


9. Choose the **Servers** tab. Check **My server requires authentication**. Click **Settings**.





10. Choose **Use same settings as my incoming mail server** and click **OK**.
